Type of Program

- Participation in monthly digital and live Wine & Cheese evenings with top speakers.
- A one-on-one final mentoring conversation with a faculty member of choice.
- Pre-work assignments, course materials, lecture notes, and session videos are available exclusively to our Fellows through our LNA Learning Hub.
- Each Fellow receives an exclusive onboarding and offboarding conversation with our CEO Sabine Hansen.

Timeframe


